### 2022 Invited Speaker—Dr. Caio Miguel



Dr. Caio Miguel is a Professor of Psychology and Director of the Verbal Behavior Research Laboratory at California State University, Sacramento. He holds adjunct appointments at Endicott College, MA., and at the University of SaPo Paulo, Brazil. He is the past-editor of *The Analysis of Verbal Behavior* and a former Associate Editor for the *Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis*. Dr. Miguel's research focuses on the study of verbal behavior and stimulus control. He has given hundreds of professional presentations around the world, and has had over 90 manuscripts published in English,

Portuguese, and Spanish. He is the recipient of the 2013 award for outstanding scholarly work by the College of Social Sciences and Interdisciplinary Studies at Sacramento State, the 2014 Outstanding Mentor Award by the Association for Behavior Analysis International (ABAI), the 2019 VBSIG Award for Excellence in Teaching Verbal Behavior, the 2019 Alumni Achievement Award from the Department of Psychology at Western Michigan University, and the 2020 Jack Michael Award for Outstanding Contributions to Verbal Behavior.
